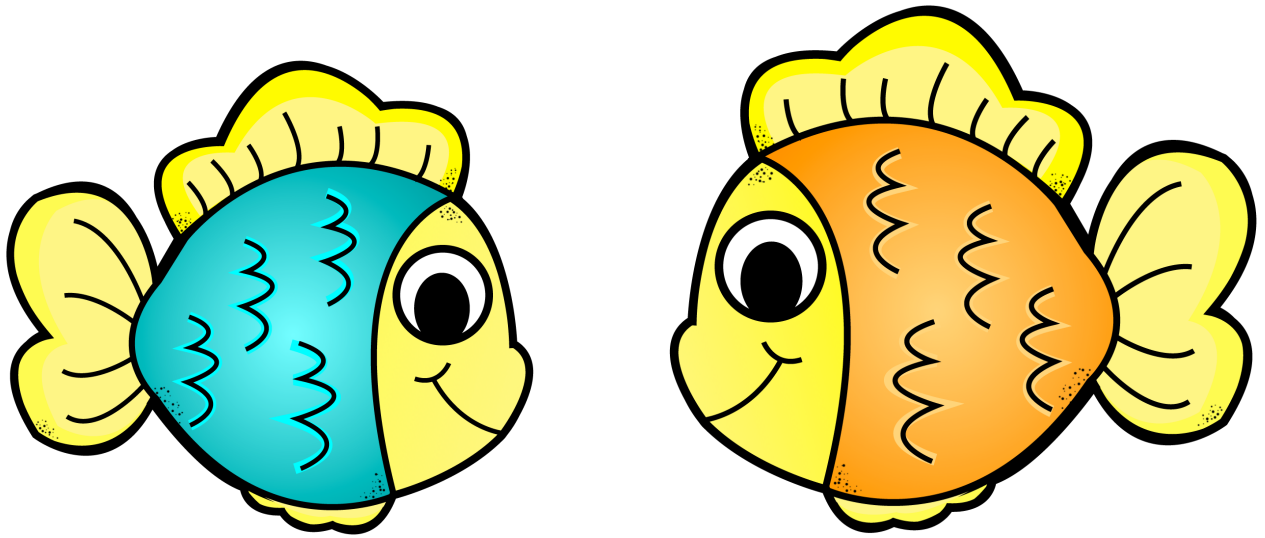

I'm a Fish (Original Author Unknown)

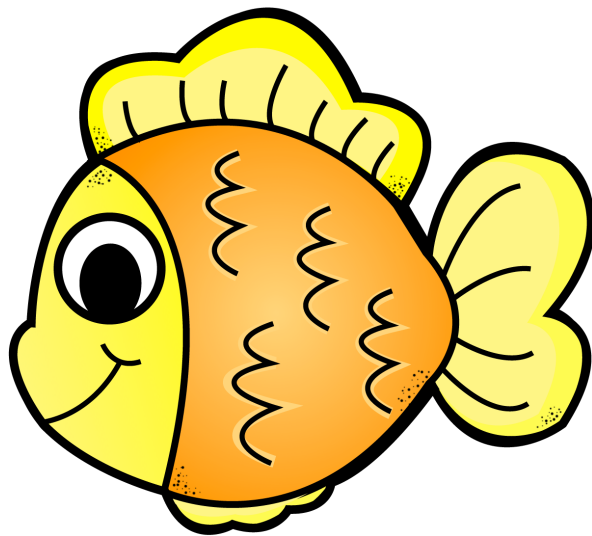
Sung to: "I'm A Little Teapot"

When I want to have fun with my friends

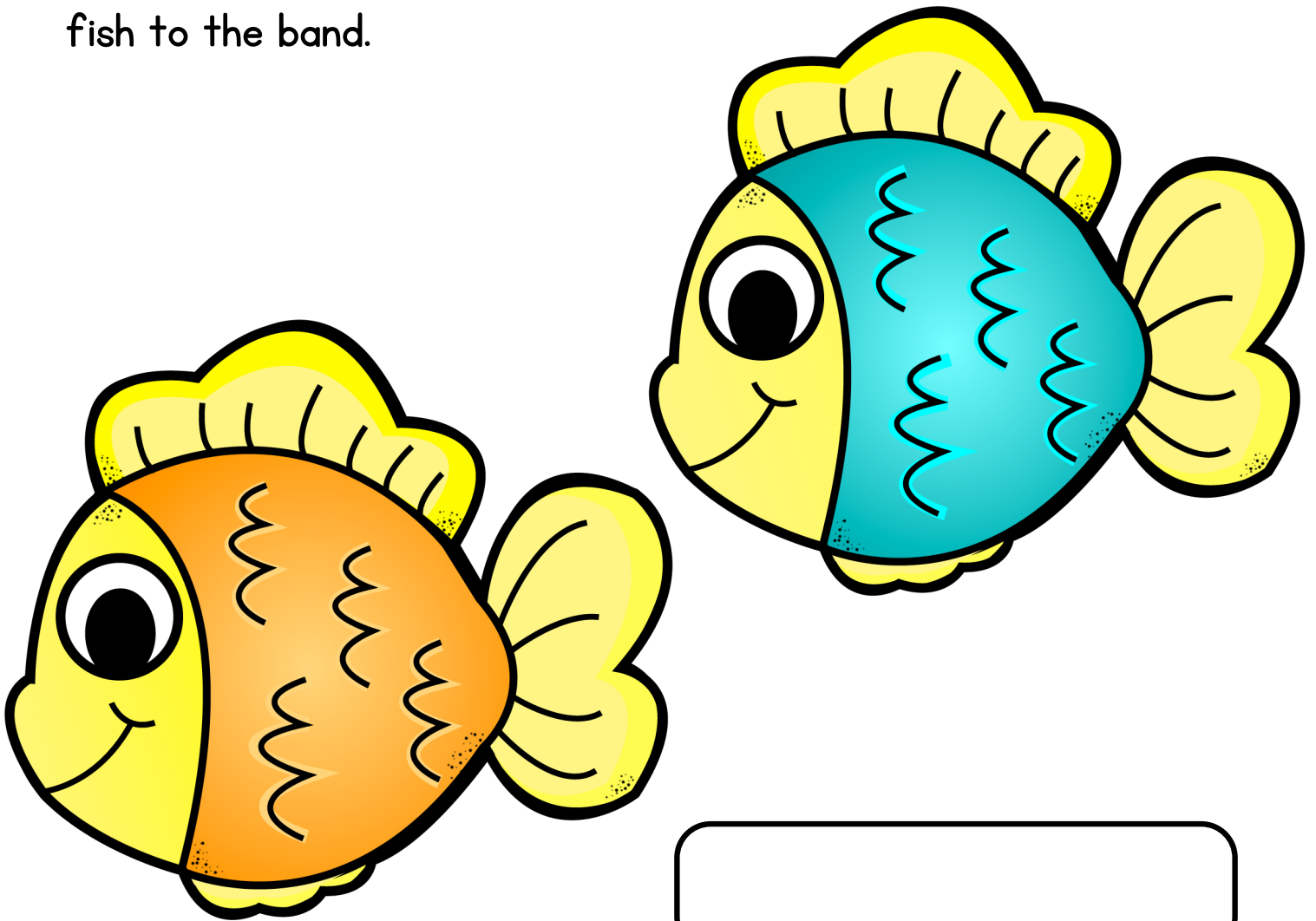
I wiggle my tail, and dive right in!

Round and Round and fast they go

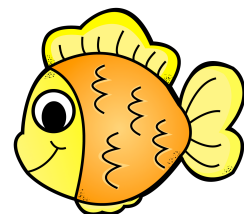
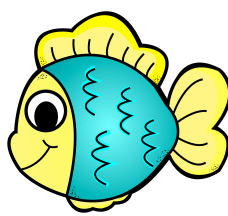
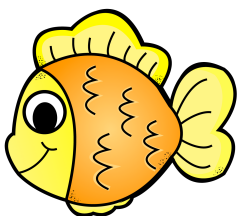
("swim" fast - sing fast)

One dug a deep, deep hole. Then there were two.

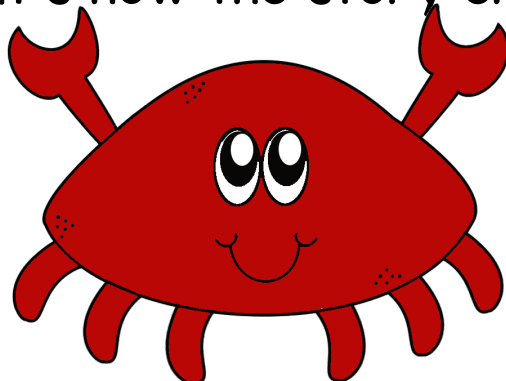
Two cranky crabs were warming in the sun.

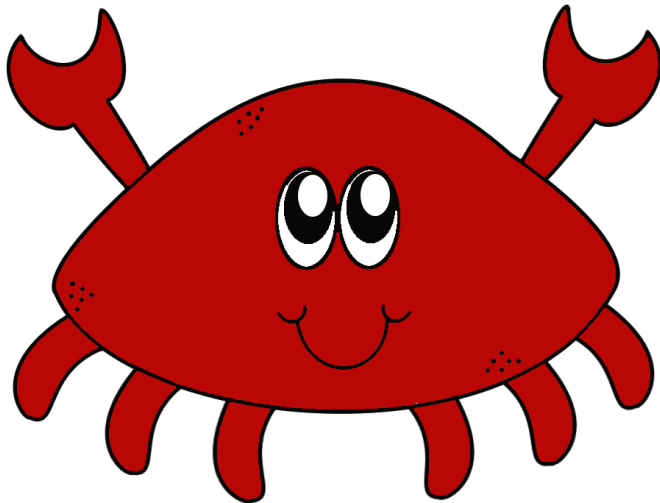
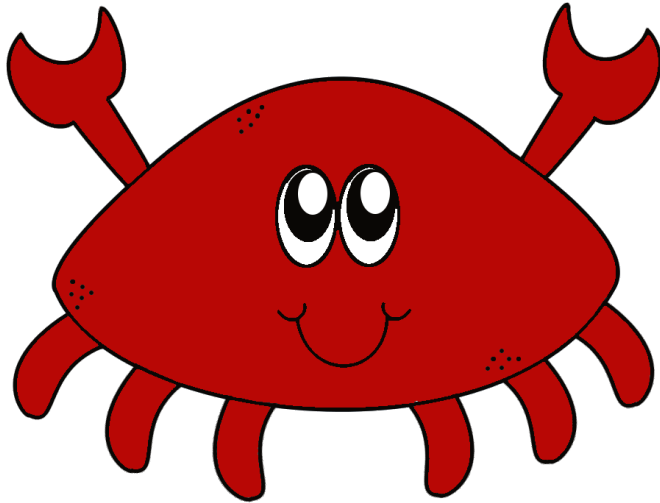
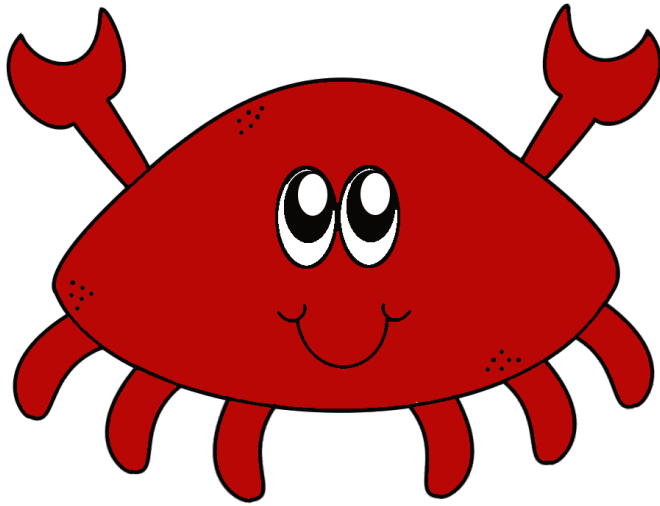
One got scooped up in a cup. Then there was one.

One cranky crab was smarter than his friends.

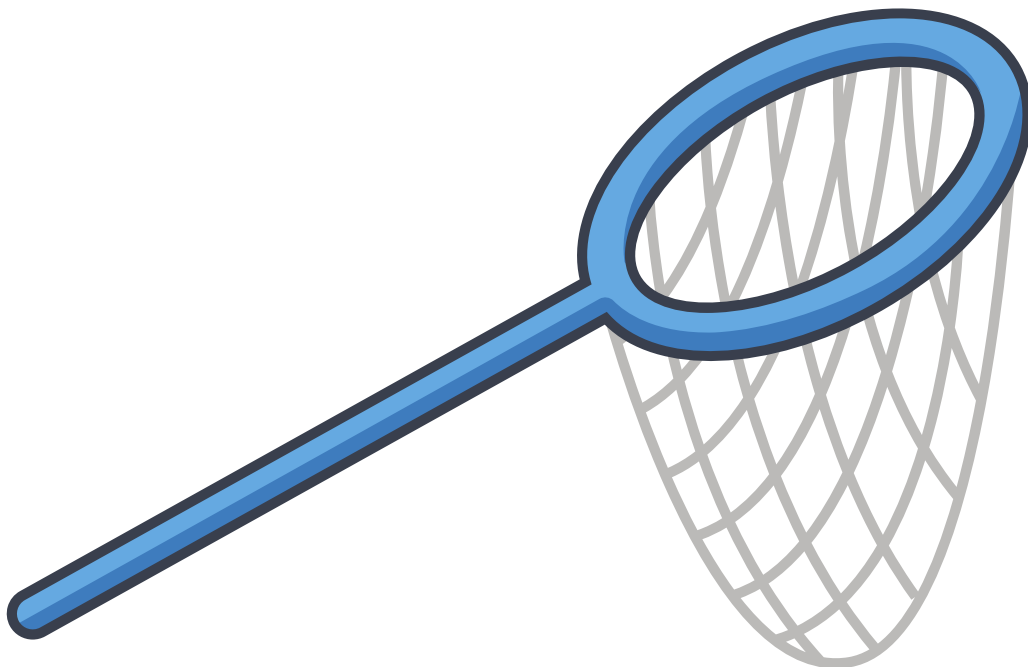
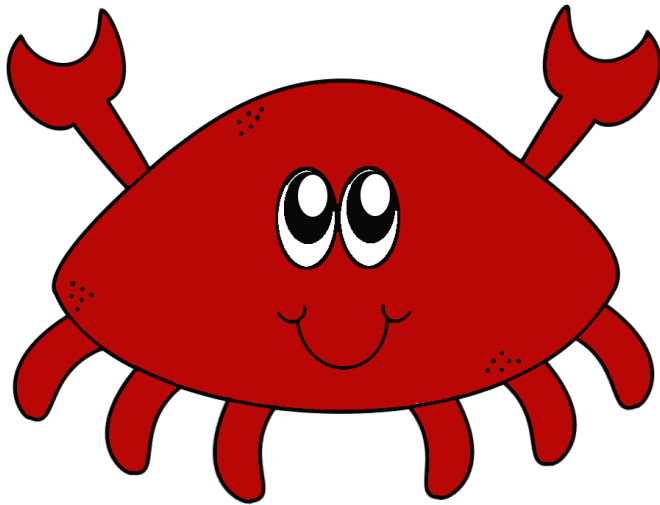
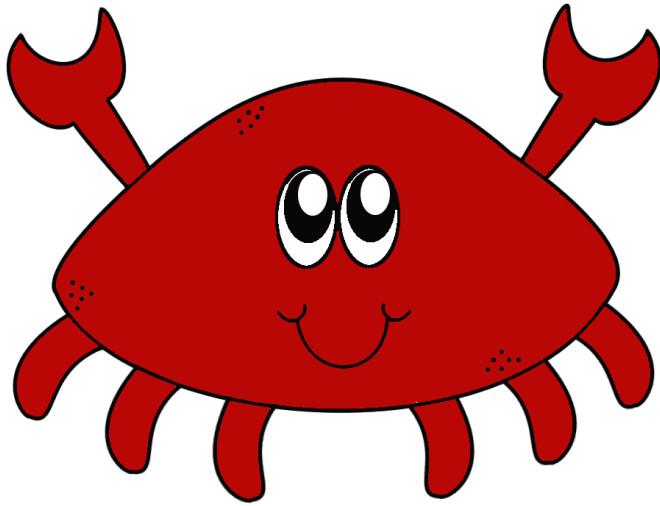
